



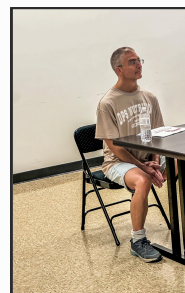

**PRODUCERS MEET-AND-GREET & ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING RECAP:
A Year of Growth & New Directions**

We're excited to share a recap of our recent producer meeting last June 18, 2024 held at the Kenhill Center and virtually. We discussed the channel's progress, challenges, and upcoming plans.

Key Takeaways:

- **Growth and Success:** We celebrated the success of several shows that have reached 10+ episodes. Our YouTube channel continues to thrive, with significant increases in views, subscribers, and watch time.
- **New Policies:** To maintain consistency and quality, we've implemented new policies, including a minimum of 2 episodes monthly for producers and updated producer dues which went into effect on July 1, 2024, and a standing dues period where all dues will be paid each year between July 1 and August 31.
- **Community Engagement:** We're committed to educating the community about TV broadcasting and storytelling. We'll continue to explore partnerships with local organizations and businesses to expand our reach.
- **Studio of Bowie:** We're committed to continue working with the city of Bowie to partner on ways to gain more studio usage.
- **Challenges and Solutions:** While we've made significant strides, we've also discussed challenges like obtaining accurate TV viewership data. We're working on solutions to address these issues and ensure the channel's continued success.
